## Proposed Program

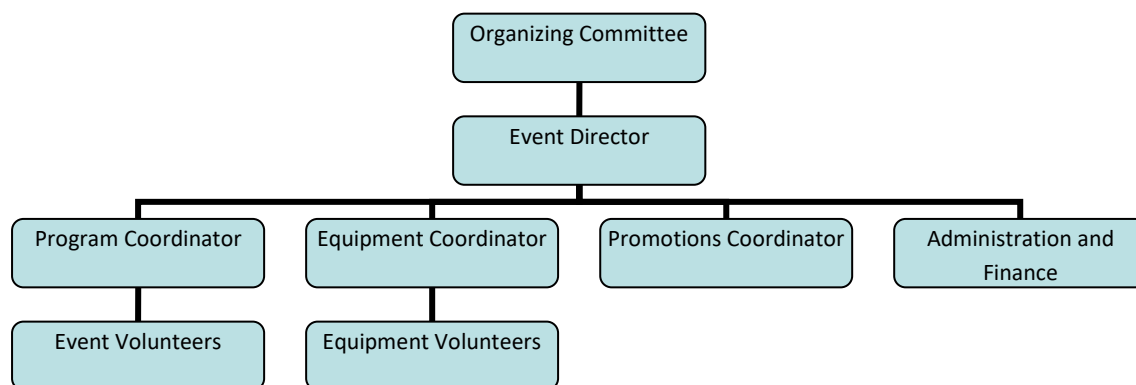
Provide a timetable for the event. It is appreciated that any timetable you provide will likely undergo many adjustments leading up to the event. The timetable might include:

- when can participants ship to venue
- who will receive shipping crates and supply security
- arrival times for participants (and officials if any) each day
- start and finish times for event participation each day
- award presentation times

## The Venue

## Budget

Prepare a statement of anticipated income and expenditure.

Only include sponsorship in the anticipated income if it has already been negotiated with the sponsor or sponsors. Proposals for the 2022 IMAC Worlds should not be based on overly optimistic financial scenarios

## Risk Management

Strategies to identify and manage risk are essential for making the final selection of venue for the 2022 IMAC Worlds. The proposal should identify major risks, mitigating strategies, and consequences if risks are not managed. Risks must include surrounding properties, other aircraft, proximity to airports, etc. Risks may also include any relevant geo-political concerns. The following table provides an appropriate format for displaying the assessment of risks that has taken place. This table (referred to as a Risk Register) would be better in a landscape orientation.

## Venue Requirements and Format for the IMAC World Championship

- Venue must be within reasonable distance from airport and hotel accommodations.
- Variety of food establishments close to accommodations and on site food vendors.
- A single venue location that can handle a minimum of four flight stations.
- Time allowance to offer 1 Unknown and up to 3 Known sequences per flight line per day (Weather permitting).
- Pilots will remain in the same flight order as drawn after de-conflicting for shared aircraft or pilot and caller conflict. A three (3) pilot drop to the bottom after each flight.
- All classes fly same number of Unknowns and Known sequences per day, per contest.
- IMAC Scoring program will be the program used throughout the contest.
- Normalized scoring will determine the placement in each class.
- The IMAC Drop Schedule will be used throughout contest.
- Final day's scores will be withheld until Awards Banquet.
- Top 3 in each class will receive the individual trophies. Fourth to sixth place will receive an IMAC World Championship commemorative plaque.
- All pilots and Team Managers should also receive some type of a souvenir of participation.
- The IMAC World Team Trophies will be calculated using the best THREE pilots (from each country) regardless in which class they are flying. The scoring program will calculate the top three pilots with the highest percentage (%) of raw scores as compared to a possible 100% in each class. ALL flown sequences (Known and Unknown) will be tabulated. The normal drop schedule will be used when calculating the top three pilots for the Team Championship Trophy.
- There will be Individual IMAC World Freestyle Champion trophies from first to third place. Fourth to sixth place will receive an IMAC World Championship commemorative plaque.
